In Order to achieve the above, both, the school and the parents, have to work in close coordination and in perfect sync. Only then, can we, together, succeed in bringing out the best in each child.



OLD AGE HOME VISIT

G D Goenka Public School, Indore, organized a trip to an Old Age Home: RAJSHANTI ASHIYANA to

show our gesture of love to the elderly people, for the students of Grades VI to VIII on 13 April 2023.

Students viewed the working of a CNC Router, CNC Turning Lathe, Laser cutting and 3D Engraving Machine, 3D Printer and Scanner, Vinyl Cutter, etc. The mechanism was unique and interesting. Any external user can access these labs by paying a nominal fee and registration form. The infrastructure was good and the machines were maintained as well.

BIOLOGY WORKSHOP

Under the CBSE Board Project work students of our Grade XII Science were taken to Maharaja Ranjit

Singh College of Professional Studies, Indore on 26.05.2023 (Friday). Students were given hands-on training for bacterial enzyme work. They were introduced to the world of enzymes and their properties. Learning about the functions of enzymes produced by bacteria actinomycetes gave insight to our students about how they are useful at such a large scale with great efficacy. Niharika Gopalani worked on the estimation of cellulose degradation by three different isolated bacterial enzymes, whereas Aryaman Singh did his studies on the rate of cellulose

degradation by a bacterial enzyme on three different plants ie. Wheat, lentils, and gram. They successfully worked under the guidance of the Head of the Biosciences Department Dr. Sheetal Bhasin in her laboratory. Students were satisfied with their work and the results they collected. They were escorted by PGT Biology Ms. Bhagyashree Adawadkar.

MOVIE SCREENING: ZEE5 AND MINDWARS

ROBOTICS WORSHOP



"The best way to predict the future is to invent it: Alan Kay". Inspired by such wonderful and inspirational thoughts, the Robotics Training Workshop for teachers began at GD Goenka Public School, Indore on 5th June 2023. Keeping in mind the innovative and technological needs of various subjects, not only computer teachers, but teachers from other disciplines such as Science, Mathematics, and English became an integral part of it. The 24-hour long training workshop, headed by Mr Rahul and Ms Ankita from Bidyut Electronics spanned over two weeks, filled with a lot of learning and new experiences for our keen and enthusiastic teachers. The hands-on robotic projects made by teachers during the training were mainly based on hydraulic, pneumatic, solar-based, and electronic (coding based: Python) systems. Overall, the teachers felt benefitted and delighted by this entirely new learning experience, thus getting ready to impart the same learning and experience to students in their upcoming robotics classes.



CLASS ASSESSMENT AND EVALUATION WORKSHOP

She emphasized the need for careful planning of the learning sessions, the use of a variety of instructional strategies and materials, and the utilization of examples from children's daily lives to help them understand concepts more clearly. She even recommended using effective planning strategies to make the best use of the resources that are available. She recommended that evaluations be conducted using well-organized techniques. She also urged that the pupils adopt the same principles. She talked about how educators are the organization's weapons and how they must collaborate to achieve a win-win outcome for everyone.

The second day of the workshop included – REVAMPING AND STRENGTHENING THE ACADEMIC OPERATIONS. She helped the teachers realize the many diverse facets of multiple intelligence in a very subtle and original way. The course sought to assist instructors in fostering both their personal and professional growth. To enable instructors to have a greater impact in the classroom, she places emphasis on keeping a positive outlook and motivating level.

She informed us of the several level-specific observation rubrics used by teachers. The notebook correction was a topic that was thoroughly discussed.

The workshop was concluded by suggesting the teachers utilize good techniques for planning, implementation, and evaluation. The workshop was reflective and goal-oriented.
